 - 6. Developmental Promotion

- Included in the decision tree is secondary follow-up steps depending on whether child is eligible or not for services
 - > For example: Right now, pathway stops when a kid is ineligible
 - Important to think about secondary referrals and pathways for the EI-ineligible children
