**Examples of Innovation to Consider** 

### General Overview of Issue-Focused Interventions by Integrated Behavioral Health in Primary Care:

- Integrated Behavioral Health for Preschool Children in Pediatric Primary Care. Yogman et al.
  - Overview research articles on an integrated behavioral health model that shows specific case examples using LCSW based intervention. Provides an overview of the person's training and background and interventions provided.
- Integrated Behavioral Health Prevention in Pediatric Primary Care
  - Overview created by Cincinnati Children's Hospital that emphasizes opportunities and areas of focus in first three years of life.

## Examples of Evidence-Based Models that could Inform Brief Interventions in Primary Care:

- Primary Care Triple P (Positive Parenting Program)
  - o A modified version of this model for primary care implementation in 3-6 Session
- Incredible Years Group Parenting Class
  - A research study that highlights a group-model. It is a parenting class held over 10 weeks, 2 hours per week.

# Examples of Specific Interventions Focused on Specific Issues or Specific Patient Populations

- Adverse Childhood Experiences: ACES Aware: Section 2 Only of the (Page 39-45)
  - A guide for establishing a robust and effective system for responding to ACE screenings and mitigating the toxic stress response.
  - With your site, a first phase could be that the psychoeducation about trauma/toxic stress and some first steps recommended could be done by integrated behavioral health staff in 3-6 sessions.

  - A literature review of 18 different models for addressing, in a dyadic manner, postpartum depression, in a pediatric settings.
- Autism Evaluation: The diagnosis of autism in community pediatric settings: Does advanced training facilitate practice change? Swanson et al
  - A pilot evaluating the effectiveness of training program designed to enhance autism spectrum disorder identification and assessment within community pediatric settings
- Adaptation for populations with inequitable outcomes: Adapting a Preschool Disruptive Behavior Group for the Underserved in Pediatric Primary Care Practice. Raglin Bignall et al



- A pilot studying the use of structural and cultural adaptations to behavioral parent training for an urban, low-income, predominantly Black population
